## **Congratulations to CCV members Carol and Jack!**



# **Updated COVID-19 Boosters Available**



Vaccines designed to better protect against new COVID-19 omicron subvariants are now available in our community. The enhanced protection is critical now that students are back in school and <u>flu season is upon us</u>. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) <u>authorized updated booster doses earlier this month</u>. Austin Public Health (APH) has received and is administering the bivalent booster through its Shots for Tots/Big Shots clinics, and the Mobile Vaccination Program (MVP) will <u>host pop-up clinics</u> in communities at risk for disparate outcomes. Many <u>retail pharmacies and providers</u> in Travis Country are already administering the updated boosters.
