As we enter into our 12th Year of assisting Seniors to live and thrive in their homes as they age, many good things are happening at Capital City Village. Our new Executive Director, Johanna Mandel has brought enthusiasm and creativity to CCV! After providing wise leadership for the CCV Board, Ellen Ward is rotating off the Board and is actively planning new adventures. And, we are very pleased that Lori Forgay has been appointed as a New Board Member and brings great commitment and knowledge to her new role. Johanna has “led the charge” to finalize CCV’s Strategic Plan, and it’s looking good! The 2023 Budget has been approved, and we are “In the black” as a free standing non-profit agency--no easy task in Austin these days. We had an excellent turnout for our Annual Meeting, which was both informative and fun. An important agenda item was the CCV Annual Survey which was implemented by Barbara Epstein, Board Member, with the assistance of Sue Hoffman and Amelia Card, UT School of Social Work Master’s Degree Intern. In response, the CCV Board along with volunteers from several committees will work to deliver and promote a broader variety of activities in multiple locations to engage more participants increasing CCV’s visibility to potential CCV members, volunteers and donors in the future.

And thanks to all for supporting Amplify Austin with generous donations of over \$8,000!

The dates for our two major fundraisers are set. The CCV/TUMC Golf Tournament will be on Saturday, September 23 at Riverside Golf Course. The Keep Aging Weird Luncheon will be held at the Norris Center on Thursday, November 9. Please save these dates!


April 16-22 is Volunteer Week!
