# Celeb Salons to Feature Austin's Favorite Weatherman Jim Spencer

CCV added a new program called <u>Celeb Salons</u> in 2018. It has been very successful in providing an intimate format for conversations with Austin notables like Sara Hickman, Judy Maggio and Peter Bay. We will start 2019 with a bang presenting Austin's favorite weatherman, Jim Spencer of KXAN.

Jim grew up in Lindsay, Oklahoma, in the heart of tornado alley, to which he credits his life-long fascination with the weather. He joined KXAN in 1990 and became Chief Weathercaster in 1993. Jim has been honored many times in his career, including National Weather Association's Weathercaster of the Year Award, three Emmys, five-time winner of the Texas Associated Press Best Weathercast Award, named Austin's Best Weathercaster 20 times by the Austin Chronicle, and five-time winner of the TV Personality of the Year by Austin's American Women in Radio and TV Chapter.



The initial seminar(s) will be "iPhone Basics". This is for Apple iPhone (NOT iPad, Android or other smartphone/tablet) users at this time.


#### Details:

NOTE: to check the version you are on - touch: Settings, then General, then About – the Version is shown about halfway down the list.

If it does NOT show 12.1 or later, you can update by going back to General, then Software Update and follow the prompts.
